

## **Press release – suspect wanted for murder**

### Murder suspect wanted

**Danish Police are looking for 30-year-old Polish citizen Michal Tamasz Kapicki, whom the police suspects of the murder of a 29-year-old Polish man on 6 January 2024 at a hotel in the town of Brøndby, Denmark.**

The local Danish police district Western Copenhagen Police, who are investigating the case, believe that Michal Tamasz Kapicki left Denmark after the murder and has since stayed in Sweden, Germany and Poland.

On 12 January Western Copenhagen Police issued an international arrest warrant for Michal Tamasz Kapicki for extradition and prosecution in Denmark.

Michal Tamasz Kapicki is 30 years old, approx. 187 cm tall, of average build, has fair skin and short dark blond hair.

"If anyone sees Michal Tamasz Kapicki, please contact the nearest police. I would also like to encourage Michal to turn himself in," says Superintendent Brian Hansen, head of the investigation at Western Copenhagen Police.

Western Copenhagen Police has requested the police in Sweden, Germany and Poland to search for Michal Tamasz Kapicki.

On 14 February, a 22-year-old man was remanded in custody by the Court in Glostrup (Denmark) in the same case.
